## IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER Monitoring Requirements Not Met for Hidden Lake Subdivision Water System

Our community water system violated a drinking water requirement. Even though this was not an emergency, as our customers, you have the right to know what happened, what you should do, and what we are doing to correct this situation. We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During the compliance period of 12/01/2024 to 12/31/2024, we did not complete all monitoring or testing for Total Coliform and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of your drinking water during that time.

## What should I do?

What is being done? Our water system monitored microbiological contaminants on 8 January 2025 with satisfactory results thus bringing our water system back into compliance.
